Visit the impressive Coba archeological site, follow its ancient roads to the tallest Mayan temple in the region. Delve into nature and meet a real Mayan family in the village of Esmeralda, which guards the secrets of their ancestors. Swim in the wonderful, crystal clear water of a cenote, and enjoy a delicious regional meal.
