Visit to Chichen Itza, one of the seven wonders of the world, and one of the most important cities of the Mayan world. Travel comfortably aboard one of the area’s buses. Learn about its history during the guided tour of the temples and the pyramid. Enjoy the local cuisine, purify body and soul swimming in a natural well of crystalline underground water, and enjoy the panoramic view of a beautiful colonial city.

Includes: Transportation, entry ticket to the archaeological site, bilingual guide, 2 1/2-hour guided tour, international and regional buffet lunch, entry ticket, and free time at a cenote.

Doesn't include: Beverages during transportation or at the restaurant, continental breakfast, video recording taxes, personal expenses, vests and lockers at the cenote.

Recommended: Comfortable clothes, comfortable shoes, swimsuit, towel, hat, sunglasses, camera, sunscreen and extra money.

Observations: Swimming in the cenote is optional and you cannot get off the unit during the sightseeing tour of Valladolid. It is not allowed to climb the main pyramid or the temples, please consult your guide regarding the archaeological site rules. You cannot enter with a backpack.

Health restrictions: The tour is not recommended for persons that have trouble walking, passengers in wheelchairs should bring a companion to assist them when getting on and off the unit during the tour.
