

Cobá Mayan Encounter

Visit the impressive Coba archaeological site, travel its ancient roads to Nohoch Mul, the highest temple in the area, which can still be climbed. Venture into the jungle and get to know a Mayan community, where you can enjoy its natural beauty: cenotes, lagoons, hikes in the jungle. You can also, cross the skies in exciting zip-lines and you will rappel down to the depths. Lastly, you will swim in unaltered cenotes of crystalline water and you will enjoy a typical lunch.

- Includes: Transportation in small groups; local cuisine; waters; archaeological guide; equipment for all the activities; entry ticket to the archaeological site, towel and locker.
- **Doesn't include:** Tips, photographs, handicrafts and/or souvenirs.
- Recommended: Comfortable shoes, swimsuit already on, light clothes, hat or cap, a change of clothes, and extra cash.
- Observations: Persons under the influence of alcohol or any toxic substance cannot participate. At Mayan Encounter, for your safety, the use of any type of photographic cameras is not allowed (or of any mobile devices including cellular phones and tablets) except "action cam" style (Go Pro) cameras, provided it is adjusted to a chest or head mounting during the entire tour.
- Health restrictions: This expedition is not recommended for disabled persons, or that suffer from heart or respiratory conditions, or back problems. It is not recommended for pregnant women, and access to children of less than 6 years is not allowed. Maximum weight for rappel and zip-lines: 120 kg. Maximum measurements for rappel and zip-lines: waist 60-105 cm, leg up to 67 cm.
