In the Mayan jungle, head into the stunning Sac-Actun system, the longest underground river in the world, explored and recommended by specialized National Geographic Snorkeler scuba divers. Snorkel surrounded by thousand-year-old rock formations and cross the jungle in Unimog all-terrain vehicles. Rappel down and swim in the gorgeous Yaxmuul cenote. On the trip you will also enjoy nature and witness an authentic Mayan ceremony. The nature park is exclusive for our small groups.

-  **Includes:** Transportation for small groups, traditional food, water, archeological guide, gear for the activities, entry to Tulum, 4x4 vehicle ride, towel, and locker.
-  **Doesn't include:** Tips, photographs, handicrafts and souvenirs.
-  **Recommended:** Wear your bathing suit, comfortable shoes, light clothing, cap or hat. Bring change of clothes and extra cash for photographs and souvenirs.
-  **Observations:** Only children age six and up. People under the influence of alcohol or any other substance will not be allowed to participate. For your safety, at Mayan Jungle, cameras of any kind (including mobile devices such as cell phones and tablets) are not allowed. Only "action cam" (Go Pro) style cameras are permitted, provided they are fastened to a chest or head mount for the duration of the trip.
-  **Health restrictions:** Zip line weight limit 264 lbs (120 kg), zip line measurement limits: waist 23.6"-41" (60-105 cm), leg: up to 26.4" (67 cm). Not recommended for people with disabilities, or heart, respiratory, or back problems. Not recommended for pregnant women.
