

Cancun, Quintana Roo, August 20 2020

Dear Business Partners,

This is to make you aware of Tropical Depression Fourteen that has formed in the Caribbean Sea, close to Nicaragua and Honduras. This system is forecast to approach the Yucatan Peninsula, by late Saturday.

The Government of the State of Quintana Roo has advised, this afternoon, of the following predictions:

- It will make a landfall in 48 hours from now.
- It will enter land by the South of Tulum, in Punta Allen a small town that will be evacuated.
- It may affect Valladolid in Yucatan as well as the island of Holbox.
- It will be in our State for 12 hours.
- Right now the possibilities of the storm to become a hurricane are minimal

We will be closely monitoring it and advising of its development. BD Experience has already activated phase one of the hurricane procedures.
