Hurricane Delta reaches category 2, Quintana Roo issues Red Alert

BD Experience would like to inform you that, before the imminent arrival of "Delta", it is important to take all the necessary measures to guarantee the safety of our clients.

According to official information from the Quintana Roo authorities, in their 9:00 am report, hurricane "Delta" intensified to category 2 on the Saffir Simpson scale. The State Coordination of Civil Protection Quintana Roo, announced that the center of the hurricane is located 675 kilometers east-southeast of Cozumel and 710 kilometers southeast of Cancun, the hydrometeorological phenomenon presents maximum sustained winds 155km.

Due to the proximity of the category 2 hurricane "Delta", the Red Alert (Maximum Danger) was issued for the North of Quintana Roo. With this in mind, we are ready to follow up on the indications of the authorities of Civil protection, however, given the uncertainty of the behavior of hurricane "Delta", we suggest you try to return our mutual clients to their countries of origin.

As we mentioned, at **BD Experience** we are prepared to provide our clients with the security that they require, but in these cases, it is always better to reassure tourists about the possibility of returning to their homes to avoid the inconveniences of this type of natural phenomenon.
